The Maitland SunRail station is located on the opposite side of I-4 from Ravago Americas offices, but that didn't deter employees from wanting to ride SunRail to/from work. Ravago Americas has invested in employees by leasing a Workplace Connector and hiring Joe, the driver, to connect employees to/from the station Monday – Friday. The Workplace Connector makes multiple trips each morning and evening during commuting hours.

Workplace Connectors are vans or 7-passenger Chevrolet Traverses that are leased month to month by companies or groups of employees directly. SunRail provides Workplace Connectors a designated parking space in SunRail parking lots.

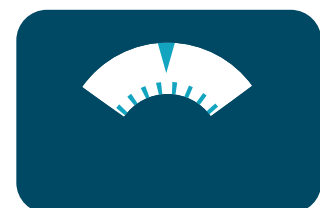
