



WORKING HARD TO KEEP YOU SAFE

SunRail's goal is to continue delivering the high-level commuter service the public relies upon while enhancing attention to the health and safety of crews and riders. From the moment passengers arrive at the station they can experience the prevention and cleaning efforts made by the staff and SunRail ambassadors.

- All SunRail ambassadors, conductors, engineers, security, and cleaning staff are required to wear a mask and practice social distancing while working.
- Per TSA guidelines, riders are required to wear masks while onboard trains. If you do not have a mask, Station Ambassadors and Train Conductors have disposable masks available for your use.
- A protective film has been placed over station machines to preserve their integrity while they, and other frequently touched areas, are disinfected by ambassadors throughout the day, and water fountains have been turned off.
- The security presence onboard provides added peace of mind, directs passenger flow, and provides additional rider support.
- Floor graphics and doorway signs have been placed on board to provide directional markers for riders to move about the train in a uniform direction, reducing the amount of face-to-face interaction.
- Cleaning crews travel on every train throughout the day wiping down frequently touched surfaces.
- Every train is equipped with hand sanitizing dispensers and a well-stocked bathroom with a hand washing sink.
- Train interiors are being fogged nightly to ensure surface areas are decontaminated.
- Signage outlining the Department of Health's guidelines for the prevention of spreading germs has been installed throughout the corridor.
